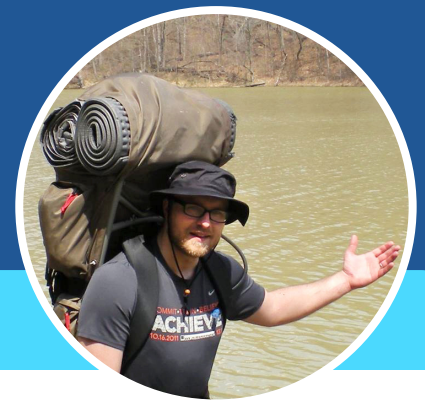


# DAN TEYNOR

### WATCHER:

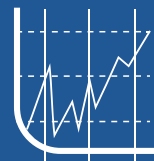
- Show me a correct example
